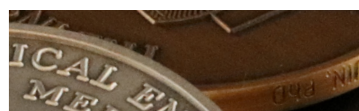

Terms & conditions

1. Eligible persons are students from any country studying any subject.
2. The prize will be £750 plus up to £250 in travel expenses for the medal presentation. Runners-up may also be selected and will each receive a certificate and have their submission published on the LPB website.
3. The prize will be awarded to the best presentation (preferably multimedia) of a major accident and the learning outcomes.
4. The language of the competition is English.
5. We invite entries from individuals or teams (of which the members are to be individually eligible) and particularly encourage cross discipline teams.
6. Where the entry relates to the Intellectual Property of persons other than the entrants, due acknowledgement must be made, and permission obtained as appropriate.
7. Similarly, presentation materials used in the entry can only be used with permission of the originator and with due acknowledgement.
8. The entrant(s) must create and present the entry themselves, but may obtain assistance with, for example, the production of a video.
9. Entrants will retain the copyright of their material, but IChemE will be deemed to have the permission of the entrants to publish the videos on the LPB website, YouTube® etc.
10. The closing date for entries is 31 October. Entries to be judged by a panel representing the LPB and IChemE. The judging panel's decision is final.

Podcast and video

- <five minutes;
- MP3 for audio files;
- AVI, MOV, or MP4 files for videos;
- podcasts/videos do not need to be professionally produced, but the picture and audio must be clear. If you are using graphics or other visual aids, please make sure they can be clearly seen.
