DEEPWATER HORIZON DISASTER

On the 20th of April 2010, a catastrophic oil well blowout occurred onboard the Deepwater Horizon Oil Rig which resulted in 11 deaths, the demise of the rig, and the largest oil spill in history. The events which led to the accident and the emergency response have since become a landmark case in process safety, law, and politics.

This is an interactive experience used to explain the process safety requirements for offshore drilling, following the Disaster. It explains the events which unfolded, allowing knowledge to be tested through quizzes and puzzle games and includes an interactive 3D-model of the rig.
